Penny Wars

THE GOAL:

Collect as many pennies as possible, preferably more than the opposing team

THE RULES:

- Split into groups; classes, boys vs. girls, etc.
- Teams will collect pennies in a container kept in a centralized location (must be accessible to opposing teams)
- Opponents can deposit silver coins or paper money into the competition's container
- Silver coins & paper money will negate the equivalent value of pennies (i.e.- a \$1.00 bill lowers your opponent's balance by 100 pennies)
- The contest can last as long as you would like; we suggest the longest period be one month
- The winning team will be decided based on the total amount of pennies minus the total amount of paper money and silver coins
- The school or teacher should honor the winning team with a pizza party, prizes, etc
